 of Josephine County Courthouse, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of
 McMullen Creek, tributary of Deer Creek, appropriated under Application No. 34096,
 Permit No. 27051

for the purposes of
storage of water in Lake Josephine Reservoir for recreation
 under Reservoir Permit No. R-2554 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
 waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
 hereby confirmed dates from **September 22, 1960**

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
 said, shall not exceed **1675 acre feet**
