CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Pacific Power and Light Co. successor to Deschutes Power and Light Co.

of Bend, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Deschutes River

for the purpose of Power generation, ice removal and debris removal

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 491; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from December 21, 1905

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1325.0 cubic feet per second for power generation; 10.0 cubic feet per second for ice removal; and 40.0 cubic feet per second for debris removal, said water for debris removal to be used only between Nov. 1 and April 1 and then only at such times as the waters of the Deschutes River are not being stored for irrigation. A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Power Plant situated in the SW1/4NW1/4, Section 32, T. 17 S., R. 12 E., W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
