CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That the Central Oregon Irrigation District, successor to the Cline Falls Power Company

of Redmond, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Deschutes River

for the purpose of Power for generation of electrical energy and Domestic use.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 491; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from February 2, 1892

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 90.0 cubic feet per second for power generation

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Power Plant situated in the SW 1/4 Sec 11, Section 11, T. 15 S., R. 12 E., W.M.

Domestic use in the SW 1/4 Sec 11 and SE 1/4 Sec 11, Section 11 and the NW 1/4 Sec 14, Section 14, T. 15 S., R. 12 E., W.M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
