## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Walter Mackay and Fletcher Linn

of 1214 Macadam St., Portland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of  
the waters of Walker Creek, a Tributary of Jackson Creek  
for the purpose of irrigation of 60 acres, and Domestic and Stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby  
confirmed dates from 1865

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.75 cubic foot per  
second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant  
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

37.7 acres in ~~NW 1/4~~ SE 1  
8.2 acres in ~~SW 1/4~~ SE 1  
4.3 acres in ~~NE 1/4~~ SW 1  
9.8 acres in Lot 2 (~~SW 1/4~~ NE 1)

## Note:

This certificate is issued to correct and supersede that certain  
water right certificate heretofore issued and recorded in State Record  
of Water Right Certificates, volume 13 at page 16106, so as to correctly  
describe the place of use in accordance with an Order of the Circuit  
Court for Jackson County dated August 16, 1961.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
