CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST L. GOSLEY

of P. O. Box 262, Riddle, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 2.2 acres

under Permit No. 25171 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 4, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.03 c.f. s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the ~~16th E. 1/4~~, as projected within Yocum DIC 43, Section 19, T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 2.2 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within J. Yocum DIC 43
Section 19
T. 30 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south line of County Road #204 which is 50 ft. south of center of said Section 19 as established by County Surveyors Office; thence running from said beginning point N. 89° 50' E. 598.4 ft. along south line of said County Road to a 3/4" Iron Rod; thence continuing along south line of said road S. 41° 29' E. 48.4 ft. to a 3/4" iron pipe; thence leaving said road line and running S. 60° 31' W. 352.2 ft. to a 3/4" iron pipe; thence S. 18° 40' J. 157.1 ft. to a wooden plug in a rock ledge; thence continuing S. 18° 40' W. 69.7 ft. to center of South Umpqua River, thence N. 65° 42' W. 79.7 ft. to a point; thence N. 38° 35' W. 286.8 ft. to a point on the west side of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19; thence running North 166.0 ft. along said west side of the place of beginning, containing 3.19 acres more or less, which is parcel farthest to the west.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
