## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. V. JOHNSTON and DOUGLAS PLUMLEY

of Medford, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Dry Creek, tributary of Antelope Creek (Little Butte Creek) appropriated under Application No. 18758, Permit No. 14363

for the purposes of irrigation under Reservoir Permit No. R-746 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 28, 1938

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 230.0 acre feet
