**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That ALBERT and FAYE VOGEL**

of Rt. 1, Box 464 Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 5.0 acres

under Permit No. G-1631 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 27, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Section 4, T. 17 S., R. 4 W., W.M. Well location: 1150 ft. North and 325 ft. West from the S.E. corner, Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ )  
 Section 4  
 T. 17 S., R. 4 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the North line of the James Peck DIC 50, T. 17 S., R. 4 W., W. M. 16.22 chains East of the Northwest corner thereof and running thence North 447.48 feet to the Southerly right of way of the County Road; thence East along the Southerly right of way of said County Road, 488.0 feet, thence South 461.0 feet to the North line of said Peck claim; thence Westerly along the North line of said Peck claim 488.0 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
