**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** MRS. JOHN P. FEUERSTEIN

of 4840 S. W. Olson Road, Portland 19, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Fanno Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.4 acre

under Permit No. 24123 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 21, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 13, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 13  
T. 1 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point 667 feet west and 418 feet north of the southeast corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 13, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., W. M., in Washington County, Oregon; thence running west 336 feet to the center of county road known as Olson Road; thence N. 11° 53' W. following center line of said road 265.69 feet; then east 388 feet; then south 260 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
