and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker.

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume of the state of the state

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic fort per second per acre, and shall be limited to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Certificate of water right issued to R. Lee and J. M. Stewart and recorded at page 1483, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation of 323.5 acres. Subsequently, the right to the use of water appurtenant to 9 acres was transferred by order of the State Engineer entered January 26, 1962. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to R. Lee and J. M. Stewart.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
