CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON PORTLAND CEMENT COMPANY

of 111 S.E. Madison, Portland 11, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Burnt River
for the purpose of manufacturing

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 8, at page 131; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1866

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/8th cubic foot per
second during the irrigation season of each year,

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

The certificate, recorded at page 29474, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right
Certificates together with a certificate issued to Harold H. Hursh, was issued to
supersede that certain certificate issued to Harold H. and Marguerite E. Hursh and
recorded at page 12297, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates and
confirms a change in use, place of use, and point of diversion for 1/8th cubic foot
per second for manufacturing approved by an order of the State Engineer entered
April 11, 1949, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530. This cer-
tificate is issued to correct and supersede the certificate recorded at page 29474,
Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates so as to correctly show the
date of priority.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
