## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That ALTON E. and LEIA S. RICE

of Box 15, Dillard , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 13.7 acres

under Permit No. 26675 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 31, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $\mathbb{N}^1_{\frac{1}{4}}$ , as projected within Phipps DIC 37, Section 3, T. 29 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the cmount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the S. Umpqua River is more than 60 cubic feet per second at its mouth,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.9 acres 14.4 14.4

Section 3 8.8 acres NE 1 NE 1 Section 4

both as projected within Phipps DIC 37 T. 29 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe on the South Line of the Robert Phipps D.L.C. in T. 29 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Douglas County, Oregon, said beginning point being 862.0 ft. East of the Southwest corner of said Land Claim; thence running North 0.11' West 67h ft. to an iron pipe on the Southerly line of the Willis Creek Co. Read; thence running along said road line South 76 01' East 33h.0 ft. South 77 12' East 361.6 ft. South 58 0h' East 527.3 ft. and South h8 12' East 350.0 ft. to a point on the South line of said Robert Phipps DLC; thence West 1383.0 ft. along the South Line of said claim to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
