CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOE M. and F. IRENE OLLIS

of P. O. Box 211, Cave Junction . , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Illinois River

a tributary of Rogue River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 22.6 acres

under Permit No. 26610 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 11, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE4 SE4. Section 17, T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 32 scre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.6 acres NE 2 SE 2 Section 17 12.5 acres SW 2 SW 2 h.5 acres SE 2 SW 2 Section 16 T. 39 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Illinois River is more than 80 cubic feet per second at its mouth and when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 cubic feet per second at its mouth, and is subject to the terms and conditions of a stipulation recorded on Pages 199 to 200, Volume 4, Miscellameous Records of the State Engineer and by reference made a part hereof.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
