CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHNSON STOCK COMPANY

of Malin, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Kilgore Springs and waste and drainage

a tributary of Lost River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 273.2 acres

under Permit No. 21699 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 14, 1952 for 2 cubic feet per second; August 27, 1952 for 3 cubic feet per second

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

5.00 cubic feet per second being 2.5 c.f.s. from Kilgore Springs and 2.5 c.f.s. from waste and drainage

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6; SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 7, T. 41 S., R. 14 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fourtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

36.6 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
36.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
40.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$

40.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
40.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
40.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
