CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **LADD BUILDING COMPANY**

of Studio #8, Pacific Building, Portland 4, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of air conditioning

under Permit No. G-1195 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 7, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.67 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., W. M. Well is 400 ft. South and 960 ft. East from the NW corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Lots 1 and 8 and northerly one-half Lots 7 and 2, Block 171,
City of Portland.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
