of 1920 21st Avenue, Forest Grove , State of Origin , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Bend Creek, unnamed otream #2 and #3 and Max Creek

a tributary of North Fork Wilson River

for the purpose of

domestic use of 21 families, including irrigation of not to exceed 2 acre lawn and garden per family of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 29, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 cubic foot per second each from Max Creek and North unnamed creek, 0.02 cubic foot per second from South unnamed creek and 0.01 cubic foot per second from Bend Creek or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN SW4, Section 3; NE SE4, SE4, SE4, Section 4, T. 1 N., R. 7 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
