CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That **W. F. ZIMMERMAN, R. L. SMITH and HAROLD BARTSCH**
of **Pendleton**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **McKay Creek** a tributary of **Umatilla River** for the purpose of irrigation of **26.0 acres** under Permit No. **14294** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **April 13, 1940**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.49 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **See Below**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fourtieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **4½ acre feet** per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in points of diversion approved by orders of the State Engineer entered July 26, 1955 pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to E. W. Barnum and recorded at page 13421, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, said points of diversion being described as follows:

(1) The point of diversion for the irrigation of the land owned by W. F. Zimmerman is located South 28° 10' West 1627 feet from the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter, Section 21, and being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 21, T. 2 N., R. 32 E., W. M.

(2) The point of diversion for the irrigation of the land owned by C. R. Smith is located 694 feet South and 1929 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 21, T. 2 N., R. 32 E., W. M. and being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 21.

(3) The point of diversion for the irrigation of the land owned by Harold E. Bartsch is located 2640 feet South and 2170 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 21, and being within SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 21, T. 2 N., R. 32 E., W.M.

(4) The point of diversion for the irrigation of the land owned by Harold E. Bartsch, successor to F. L. Ingram is located North 50° 30' West 470 feet from the center of Section 21, and being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, said Section 21, T. 2 N., R. 32 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
