This Is to Certify, That WHITED RESERVOIR COMPANY,
A VOLUNTARY ASSOCIATION

of Baker, Baker County, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of South Fork Burnt River appropriated under Application No. 5657, Permit No. 3738

for the purposes of

irrigation and supplemental irrigation under Reservoir Permit No. R-72 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 1, 1910

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 700 acre feet divided as follows between tracts as described in the certificate recorded on Page 29802, State Record of Water Right Certificates. ~~Tract 1 - 18/28ths, Tract 2 - 5/28ths, Tract 3 - 3/28ths,~~ Tract 4 - 2/28ths.

The reservoir is located NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 13 S., R. 36 E., W. M.
