CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EMIL and AMELIA BRITT

of Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of Little Butte Creek
for the purpose of irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 498; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from April, 1899

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per
second; measured at the head of the ditch or point where the same leaves the natural
stream, from April 1st to October 1st of each year,

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

5.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.0 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 8
T. 36 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

NOTE: Certificate of water right issued to Emil and Amelia Britt and recorded
at page 17167, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a
right to the use of water for irrigation of 51 acres. Subsequently, the right
to the use of water appurtenant to 45 acres was transferred by order of the
State Engineer entered February 1, 1961. This certificate is issued to confirm
the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the cer-
tificate heretofore issued to Emil and Amelia Britt.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
