for the purpose of the irrigation of 25 acres of land, domestic and stock use
and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 155;
that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1898
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed le acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigations eason; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitions Antesington of the thirds irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-
firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,
is as follows: 16 acres in the NW4SW4; 7 acres in the SW4SW4 and 2 acres in the NE4SW4 of Section 1, Township 2 South, Range 44 Fast of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.
The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or
place of use herein described.
