## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That SANDY FARMS

of Route 3, Box 173, Boring , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Reserveir. #3 constructed under Application No. R-28782, Permit No. R-1572 a tributary of Tickle Creek for the purpose of

supplemental irrigation of 63.4 acres

under Permit No. 22657 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 15, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.7 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $NW_4^1$   $NE_4^1$ , Section 21, T. 2 S., R. 4 E., W. N.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre, a diversion of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 1.7 acre feet per year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
