CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, walter D. and VIRGINIA D. CASON

of Box 1018, Gold Beach , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Edson Creek

a tributary of Rogue River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 1.0 acre

under Permit No. 27006 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 12, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SKI SEI, Section 8, T. 36 S., R. II, W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed his acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the Rogue River is more than 735 c.f.s. at its mouth,

and shall

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe driven at the intersection of the Easterly boundary of the Cregon Coast Highway and the Northerly boundary of the County Road at a point approximately 2h30 ft. W. and 1020 ft. N. of the S.E. corner of said Section Eight (8); thence N. 86° E. 276 ft., more or less, following the Northerly boundary of the County Road to the center of the channel of Edson Creek; thence up the center of the channel of Edson Creek approximately as follows: N. 8° 21' W. 71.9 ft.; thence N. 47° 10' W. 81.0 ft.; thence N. 78° 42' W. 77.0 ft.; thence N. 40° 19' W. 50.0 ft.; thence N. 4° 26' W. 66.5 ft.; thence N. 73° 26' W. 37.3 ft.; thence S. 77° W. 77.4 ft.; thence continuing up the center of the channel of Edson Creek and leaving it, S. 56° 40' W. 135.4 ft. to an iron pipe driven in the Northeasterly boundary of the Oregon Coast Highway right of way at a point that bears N. 35° 40' W. 226.2 ft. from the place of beginning; thence Southeasterly following the Easterly boundary of the Oregon Coast Highway right of way to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
