This Is to Certify, That S. F. RONDE

of 4225 Midway Avenue, Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Balm Slough and an unnamed stream, tributary of The Applegate River, appropriated under Application No. 32450, Permit No. 25627,

for the purposes of
irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-2155 of the State Engineer and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 13, 1958

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-said, shall not exceed 3.0 acre feet, being 0.5 a.f. in West Reservoir and 2.5 a.f. in East Reservoir.
