CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ED STEINHAUER

of Greenleaf, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Lake Creek, Steinhauer Creek and Springs Nos. 1 and 2

a tributary of Sinalaw River for the purpose of irrigation of 22.3 acres, dairy barn, stock and use in milk house, and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 24843 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 1, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second being 0.26 cfs from Lake Cr. and 0.02 cfs from Steinhauer Creek for irrigation and 0.01 cfs from Steinhauer Cr. for use in dairy barn and 0.01 cfs for stock and use in milk house and 0.01 cfs for domestic use from springs 1 & 2.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 17 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

* Water to be diverted from Spring No. 1 for domestic, milk house, and stock purposes when available and any deficiency in the available supply in Spring No. 1 is to be made up by diversion from Spring No. 2, providing that the total diversion from both springs shall not exceed 0.02 cfs, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
