CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARVIN B. and EVA L. NOBLE

of P.O. Box 298, Hebo, Oregon, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-30880, Permit No. R-1896 a tributary of Big Nestucca River for the purpose of manufacturing and domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre lawn and garden under Permit No. 24388 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 2, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second being 0.02 c.f.s. for manufacturing and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 7, T. 4 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
