CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That UIRICH WYSS, JR.

of Rt. 2, Box 185 B, Cloverdale , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek

a tributary of East Beaver (Beaver Creek and Nestucca River)

for the purpose of

irrigation of 20.4 acres, domestic use for three families and stock

under Permit No. 25356 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 26, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.27 cubic foot per second, being 0.26 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and stock

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEL SEL, Section 7, T. 3 S., R. 9 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation sesson of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic NE₄ SE₄ 8.8 acres SW₂ SE₄ Domestic and stock 11.6 acres SE₄ SE₄ Section 7
T. 3 S., R. 9 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
