CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That B. B. POMELL

of Route L, Box lik, Hood River , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Unnexaed Spring

a tributary of Columbia River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 3 acres and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 4679 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 6, 1920

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second being 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic and 0.04 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEZ SEZ, Section 26, T. 3 N., R. 75 E., I.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount see Ler any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one residence foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

domestic and 3 acres SE_4^1 SW_4^1 Section 26 T. 3 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

NOTE: Certificate of water right issued to B. B. Powell and recorded at page 3558, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of water for irrigation and the development of power. Subsequently, the right for the development of power expired. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and domestic use and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to B. B. Powell.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
