## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That

has a right to the use of

the waters of Prairie Creek, a tributary of the Wallowa River, and Wallowa River, a tributary of Grande Ronde River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 1012 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1889 for Truck No. 1 and

November 12, 1900 for Tract No. 2 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to un amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed oneoightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre for Tract No. 1 and 12 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season for Tract No. 2; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Tract No. 1/ 225 acres in the NEANN and 15 acres in the NWANN of Section 7, Township 2 South, Range 45 Fast of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County,

Irrigated from Wallowa River:
Tract No. 2:  $/36\frac{1}{2}$  acres in the NE NE of Section 12, Township 2 South,
Range 44: and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acres in the NE NW and 25 acres in the NW NV of Section 7, Township 2 South , Range 45, All East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
