for the purpose of the development of 58 horsepower

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for

Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order

Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 160;

that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 1884

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 30 cubic feet per second; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Water used at planing mill situated West of Block 4, Town of Joseph, returned to stream 165' west of Lot 10, Block 4, Town of Joseph, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
