CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That - KATE VAN DUYN COCHRAN

of Agness, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring and Cochran Creek - Water to be diverted from unnamed spring when available. Supply in unnamed spring is to be made up by diversion from Cochran Creek, providing that total quantity diverted from both shall not exceed 0.02 c.f.s. a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of

domestic use for three families under Permit No. 26337 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 21, 1959

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) - Creek; Lot 9 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) - Spring, Section 30, T. 34 S., R. 11 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 6 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Lot 9 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 30
T. 34 S., R. 11 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
