CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That the DOBBIN DITCH COMPANY, a corporation by A. W. Schaupp, Agent, of Joseph, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River, a tributary of the Grande Ronde River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 2,025.2 acres of land, domestic and stock use, and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD, of Oregon, in Volume 5, at pages 160 and 161; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 10, 1900; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed $1\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 10 acres in the $N\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$ and 30 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 8, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian, supplemented by waters from Big Bend Ditch. Also 40 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $SE\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}$ and 40 acres in the $SE\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 8; 30 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $SE\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$; 10 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}$ and 40 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 9; 40 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$ and 40 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 15; 40 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$; 35 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$; 30 acres in the $SE\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$ and 9 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 17, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 2: 40 acres in the $SE\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $SE\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$ and 40 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 16, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 3: 35 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$; 30 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$ and 10 acres in the $SE\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 21, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 4: 25 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$; 30 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$; 3 acres in the $SE\frac{1}{2}NE\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$ and 40 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 21, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 5: 40 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$ and 40 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 15, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 6: $6\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 7: 40 acres in the $NE\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$; 40 acres in the $NW\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$; 20 acres in the $SW\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$ and 30 acres in the $SE\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 29, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 8: 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 9: 20 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 5 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 10: 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 40 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian; 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20 supplemented by water from Creighton ditch. 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 40 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 12: 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 35 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 17 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 39 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 13: Lots 13, 14, 15 and 16 in Block 2, Mahon's Addition to the Town of Joseph, Oregon.

Tract No. 14: Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Block 2, Mahon's Addition to the Town of Joseph, Oregon.

All of the above described lands being in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
