## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

The right herein described is expressly subject to and subordinate to any appropriation hereafter made from Little North Santiam River for municipal or demestic purposes.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 52 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $\mathbb{N}_{4}^{1}$  SE $_{4}^{1}$ , Section 31, T. 8 S., R. 4 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ---- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Fish Ladder NW4 SE4 Section 31 T. 8 S., R. 4 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
