that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1883

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed lacre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed lacre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 160 acres in the SE_{4}^{1} of Section 30: 4 acres in the $NW_{4}^{1}SW_{4}^{1}$ and 8 acres in the $SW_{4}^{1}SW_{4}^{1}$ of Section 29, Township 1 North ,Range 43 East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
