CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ESTATE OF THOMAS E. MCGINNIS
 c/o Hugh McGinnis
 of Agness, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
 Fall Creek
 a tributary of Illinois River for the purpose of
 domestic use for two families including irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre for
 each family
 under Permit No. 20230 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
 confirmed dates from February 7, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
 The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T. 35 S., R. 11 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
 right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
 per acre,

and shall
 conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
 appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic
 Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 Section 18
 T. 35 S., R. 11 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
 use herein described.
