This Is to Certify, That GEORGE A. STOUDER

of Alsea , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

a tributary of Pacific Ocean

for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 22072 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 2, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.036 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SE $_4^1$ SW $_4^1$), Sec. 2, T. 14 S., R. 9 W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.9 acres Lot 3 (SE¹₄ SW¹₄)
Section 2
T. lh S., R. 9 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the south right of way line of the Alsea State Hi-way, which point is N. 70°16', W. 2969.2 feet from the S.E. corner of Sec. 2, T. 11 S., R. 9 W., W.M., in Lincoln County, Oregon. Thence S. 25°15', W. 126.2 feet to the Alsea River, thence meandering along the Alsea River, north westerly to the intersection of the river with the south right of way line of the Alsea State Hi-way, a distance of 620 feet more or less, thence easterly along said hiway right of way a distance of 806 feet more or less to the beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
