CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN R. EIKENBERRY

of 13225 S.W. Roger Road, Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, an unnamed stream and a reservoir constructed under App. No. R-33678, Permit No. R-2329 a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of fish culture, recreation and domestic use of two families

under Permit No. 26599 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 29, 1960

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, being 0.10 c.f.s. from unnamed stream and reservoir for fish culture and recreation and 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed spring for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 6, T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
