that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.52 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. from Elk Creek and 0.5 c.f.s. from unnamed stream

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA NWA, Sec. 17, SEA NEA, Sec. 18, T. 22 S., R. 5 W. W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _ _ _ _ _ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
