CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That VERNE E. BEAL

of Route 1, Box 233, Clackamas, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Clackamas River

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigation of 1.0 acres and maintenance of fish pond

under Permit No. 26696 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 12, 1960,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for maintenance of fish pond,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 21, T. 2 S., R. 3 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Fish Pond & 1.0 acre Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 21
T. 2 S., R. 3 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a stone on the N. bank of the Clackamas River which is 4.60 chains S. of an iron pipe in the center of the Estacada and Carver Road, which iron pipe is 3.25 chs. E. and 19.31 chs. S. from the corner of Sections 20, 21, 16 and 17, in T. 2 S., R. 3 E., W.M.; thence N. 4.60 chs. to said iron pipe; thence N. 75°40' W. 143 ft. along the center of said Estacada-Carver Road to a point; thence S. and parallel with the E. line of the tract being conveyed to a point in the N. bank of Clackamas River, in a line bearing S. 86°00' W. from the point of beginning; thence N. 86°00' to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
