CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GLENN STOCKDALE

of 16215 SE. Harold Avenue, Portland 22, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed drainage ditch

a tributary of Willarette River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 27656 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 18, 1961;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Kellogg DIC, Section 7, T. 2 S., R. 2 E., W.M. Well located N. 42° 52' W. 240 feet, then N. 45° 21' E. 249.6 ft; then N. 27° 32' W. 318 ft. from the NE corner, Rogers DIC.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.57 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within Jason Kellogg DIC
Section 7
T. 2 S., R. 2 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a stone marked 4, located at the most Westerly corner of that certain tract of land conveyed to Geo. W. Derry and Ida S. Derry, by deed recorded August 21, 1914, in Book 136 at page 502, Record of Deeds for Clackamas County, Oregon; said stone also being N. 43° 45' W. 2194.1 ft. distant from the most Westerly corner of the James McNary DIC, in said Township and Range; thence N. 45° 21' E., tracing the Northwesterly boundary of said Derry tract 249.6 ft. to an iron pipe driven in the Southwesterly boundary of a county road; thence S. 28° 16' E. tracing said road boundary 110.0 ft., which is N. 28° 16' W. 44375 ft. from an iron pipe; said iron pipe marks the most Northerly corner of a tract conveyed to Jess I. Mootry et us by deed recorded October 13, 1951, in Book 449, Page 543, Deed Records; thence S. 45° 21' W., parallel with the Northwesterly line of said Mootry tract, 220.27 ft. to the Southwesterly line of said Derry tract; thence N. 43° 45' W. 105.5625 ft. to the point of beginning, in the County of Clackamas.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
