## This Is to Certify, That EUGENE CLUFF

of Route 4, Box 174, Astoria Oregon , State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

for the purpose of

irrigation of 5.68 acres and domestic use for two families

25552 under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 28, 1958,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

9.08 cubic foot per second, being 0.07 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the MN SEL, Section 25, T. 8 N., R. 8 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, tog ther with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ene-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 2.0 acres and domestic SW NE 3.68 acres NW 3 SE Section 25 T. 8 N., R. 8 W., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

A tract of land in and adjacent to the West one-half of the SE \frac{1}{4} of Sec.

25, T. 8 N., R. 8 W., W.M., described as follows: Commencing at a point 907.50 feet East of the center of said Sec. 25; thence North 198 ft. to an iron pipe, the point of beginning of the tract of land here-by described; theree East 112.50 ft. to an iron pipe; thence South to and along the East line of said West one-half of the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  1200 ft. to an iron pipe; thence West at right angles 412.50 ft. to an iron pipe; thence North 1200 ft. to the point of beginning of the tract hereby described.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
