and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume , at page 169 :

that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 12 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree .

A description of the 1-nds irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,

is as follows: 7 acres of the following described lands, being in the NWINE of Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 42 Fast of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

Beginning at a point 660' East and North 10 degrees East 655' of SW corner of NV2NE2 of Section 15, Township 1 North, Range 42 East of Willamette Meridian; thence North 10 degrees East 592; thence East 520 more or less, to center of channel of Bear Creek; thence running in a southeasterly direction to a point due east of the place of beginning; thence West 770' to the place of beginning, containing 82 acres.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
