CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That the GRANGER WATER DITCH CO., a corporation O. T. Prout, President, of Joseph, State of Oregon. has a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River, a tributary of the Grande Ronde River, for the purpose of the irrigation of 1,068.25 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, in Volume 5, at pages 168 and 169; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 1, 1889; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 12 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such rights, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Tract No. 1: 40 acres in the $NE_4^1NW_4^1$; 40 acres in the $SE_4^1NW_4^1$; 14 acres in the $SW_4^1NW_4^1$ and 13 acres in the $NW_4^2NW_4^1$ of Section 18, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 2: 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$; 29 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$; 37 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 18: 20 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$ and 3 acres in the SF $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 3: 40 acres in the $SE_{4}^{1}SE_{4}^{1}$; 37 acres in the $SW_{2}^{1}SE_{4}^{1}$; 40 acres in the $SF_{4}^{1}SW_{4}^{1}$ and 16 acres in the $SW_{4}^{2}SW_{4}^{1}$ of Section 15, Township 2 South, Range 46 Fast of Willamette Peridian.

Tract No. 4: $E_{\mathbb{R}}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of Block 9, Riverside Addition to City of Joseph; Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7 and 8 in Block 1, Mahon's Addition to the City of Joseph. Lots 5,6,7,8,9,10,11 and 12 in Block 2, Mahon's Addition to the City of Joseph. Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8 in Block 3, Mahon's Addition to the City of Joseph, Oregon.

Tract No. 5: 40 acres in the $NE_{\pm}^{1}NW_{2}^{1}$; 40 acres in the $NW_{\pm}^{1}NW_{2}^{1}$; 20 acres in the $SW_{\pm}^{1}NW_{\pm}^{1}$ and 30 acres in the $SE_{\pm}^{1}NW_{2}^{1}$ of Section 29, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 6: 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; 12 acres in the NV $\frac{1}{4}$ MW $\frac{1}{4}$; 36 acres in the NV $\frac{1}{4}$ ME $\frac{1}{4}$ and 38 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 7: 40 acres in the $NE_{2}^{1}NE_{2}^{1}$ and 35 acres in the $SE_{2}^{1}NE_{2}^{1}$ of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 8: 28 acres in the $NF_2^1SE_4^2$; 34 acres in the $NW_2^1SE_4^1$; 40 acres in the $NW_2^1SW_4^1$ and 15 acres in the $NW_2^1SW_4^1$ of Section 18, Township 2 South, Range 45 Fast of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 9: 40 acres in the $SF_4^1SE_4^1$; 40 acres in the $SW_4^1SE_4^1$; 40 acres in the $SF_4^1SW_4^1$ and 2_4^1 acres in the $SW_4^1SW_4^1$ of Section 19, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 10: 12 acres in the $SE_2^1NW_2^1$; 40 acres in the $WW_4^1NE_2^1$; 37 acres in the $SW_4^1NE_4^1$ and 40 acres in the $NE_4^1NW_4^1$ of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East of Willamette Meridian.

All of the above described land being in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
