CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MURLAND G. JOHNSON

of Route 1, Box 674, Cottage Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Louis Slough and Southwell Creek (Willamette River) for the purpose of irrigation of 4.9 acres

under Permit No. G-2011: of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 12, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $SW_{\frac{1}{4}}SW_{\frac{1}{4}}$ as projected within Clark DLC No. 147, Sec. 2, T. 20 S., R. 3 W., W.M. Well located 77' S. and 1155.6' East from the NW corner, Robert Clark DLC No. 147.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.5 acres SW4 SW4

0.4 acres SE4 SW4

both as projected within Clark DLC 47

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the middle of a slough 4.93 chs. N. and 13.91 chs. E. of NW corner, Southwell DIC 46, T. 20 S., R. 3 W., W.M., and running thence along the middle of the slough, N. 54 E. 4.69 chs., thence N. 60 E. 6.94 chs., thence N. 67 E. 3.97 chs., thence N. 41 3/4 E. 5.0 chs., thence N. 38 3/4 E. 5.0 chs., thence N. 26 E. 3.74 chs. to a point on the N. line of Clark DIC 47, at a stone and bearing trees established by County Survey 1104, being according to said survey 11.60 chs. E. of NW corner of claim, thence E. on N. line of DIC 47, 18.99 chs., thence S. 72 32 W. 23.47 chs. to a point about 1.0 chs. northeasterly from the center of the slough, thence following about 1.0 chs. from the middle of the slough, S. 37 10 W. 2.75 chs., thence S. 45 13 W. 3.93 chs., thence S. 65 10 W. 9.0 chs., thence S. 47 12 W. 4.10 chs. to a point 15.61 chs. E. and 4.93 chs. N. of the NW corner of the Joseph Southwell DIC, thence W. 1.70 chs. to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
