CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PORTLAND MEDICAL CENTER, INC.
c/o O. H. Young, Attorney at Law,
of 800 Pacific Building, Portland 4, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
a well

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of
air conditioning

under Permit No. G-822 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from November 19, 1957;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.84 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lowndale DIC 40,
Section 34, T. 1 N., R. 1 E., W.M. Well located N. 16° 57' E. 689 feet from SW
corner, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second
per acre,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

Air conditioning
SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
as projected within Lowndale DIC 40
Section 34
T. 1 N., R. 1 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Lots 1 and 2, Block 253, City of Portland.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
