CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That W. J. HAMMOCK

of Enterprise State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Weaver Creek and Spring Branch of Weaver Creek, tributaries of Wallowa River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 5 acres of land and steam power at Saw Mill

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 171; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1890 for Tract No. 1; 1900 for Tract No. 2 and 1905 for Tract No. 3

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes

aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 acre foot per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season for irrigation and domestic and 0.20 cubic feet per second for power; and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decrees.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Tract No. 1, irrigated from Weaver Creek: 3 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 2 South, Range 44 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 2, irrigated from Spring Branch of Weaver Creek: 2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 2 South, Range 44 East of Willamette Meridian.

Tract No. 3, from Weaver Creek: Steam power at Saw Mill in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 2 South, Range 44 East of Willamette Meridian,

All of the above described lands being in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
