## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That

DUANE SPIERING

of Route 2, Box 256, Forest Grove , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-31788, Permit No. R-2092.

a tributary of : Cedar Canyon Creek (West Fork Dairy Creek)

for the purpose of

irrigation of bl. 0 acres

under Permit No. 25194 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1957,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.50 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SE_4^+$   $W_4^+$ , Section 35, T. 2 N., R. 4 W., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

35.0 acres SE3 NW 3 9.0 acres SW 1 NE 2 Section 35 T. 2 N., R. 4 W., N.N.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at the NM corner of the SE quarter of the NM quarter, Sec. 35, T. 2 N., R. 4 W., W.M. (the same being also the NE corner of the J. Richardson Homestead claim and also the NM corner of the Emmanuel Horner claim); thence South 80.00 rods; thence East 100.00 rods; thence North 80.00 rods; and thence West 100.00 rods to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
