**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT No. 509 CJ  
of City Hall, P.O. Box 610, Corvallis, State of Oregon, has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Highland View Junior High Well

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 30.4 acres

under Permit No. G-1208 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from December 22, 1958;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.22 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Stouts DLC No. 48,  
Section 26, T. 11 S., R. 5 W., W.M. Well located 42.7 chains N. and 43.0 chains  
E. from SW corner, DLC 48.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to  
a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during  
the irrigation season of each year,

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

1.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
4.5 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
5.1 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
19.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 26  
T. 11 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
