**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**      ERNIE JOHN BRADTL

of R. F. D. 3, Box 439, Canby, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 8.7 acres

under Permit No. G-1823 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 11, 1961,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

**0.11 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Fish DLC 45, Sec. 28, T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W.M. Well located 445 ft. N. and 2548 ft. W. from the SE corner of Section 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.7 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
as projected within Fish DLC 45  
Section 28  
T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Lot 45 and the North 132 feet of Lot 44, Canby Gardens.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
