aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed la acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree under such right, and to which the water hereby con-

firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,

is as follows: 20 acres in the SW1NE1 of Section 33, Township 2 North, Range 42 Wast of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.
