CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That JOSEPH A. HARRIS

of Wallowa, State of Oregon has a right to the use of
the waters of Wallowa River, a tributary of the Grande Ronde River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 20 acres of land

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5, at page 171 ;
that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1904

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
1 1/2 acre feet per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year,
and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the
irrigation season; and said right shall be subject to all other conditions and
limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby con-
firmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use,
is as follows: 20 acres in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 33, Township 2 North, Range 42
East of Willamette Meridian, in Wallowa County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or
place of use herein described.
