a tributary of Snake River

for the purpose of

therapeutic purposes and commercial heating

under Permit No. G-1318 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 5, 1959,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.17 cubic foot per second, being 0.16 c.f.s. for therapeutic purposes and 0.01 c.f.s. for commercial heating,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SE4, Section 20, T. 18 S., R. 45 E., W.M. Well located N. 27 20' West 329 feet from SE corner, SW4 SE4, Section 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ---- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
